Port Campbell to Peterborough

On leaving Port Campbell the Great Ocean Road makes a right turn over the Port Campbell creek and climbs up the west headland of Port Campbell. The C154 road that goes North is a short cut back to Melbourne see 1 day Great Ocean Road trip notes.

2.1 kilometres past Port Campbell there is a car park on the left that overlooks Port Campbell. Either walk back down the great ocean Road for approximately 100 metres or take the walk toward the steps down into Port Campbell. Both offer superb views of Port Campbell. Allow 10 minutes for this stop.

The turn to the feature The Arch is located 6.5 kilometres past Port Campbell. This is a must see feature and possibly one of the most photogenic features on the Great Ocean Road. In the late afternoon intense colours are seen on The Arch. Allow 25 minutes for this stop.

London Bridge is located 7.3 kilometres past Port Campbell. It comprises an arch that used to be joined to the mainland but fell into the water with two tourist trapped on the existing span.

The Grotto is located 9 kilometres past Port Campbell. You walk down into a collapsed cave and look through an arch back into the ocean. Allow 20 minutes to visit this feature.

If you turn left over the Curdies River you come to a car park that looks right along the coast to the east. There are toilets located near by. Allow 10 minutes for this stop.
